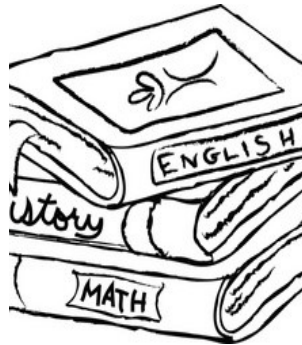
making a choice to send you kids to us when there are many choices out there. It is my pleasure and privilege to serve you and your kids.
