ing on, but it is always my hope that you discuss in, and dig into conversation with your kids about what we are doing in class. It will make for good family time.

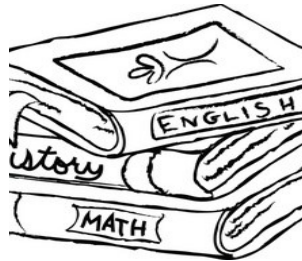
