Then the kids ask so many awesome questions. I wish you could all hear these class times. God truly blesses our school.

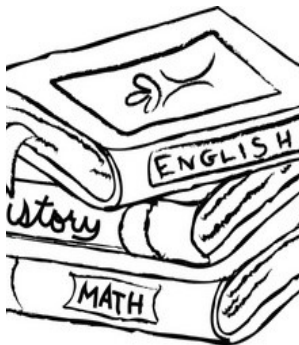
